

10. KEYHOLE RACE

a. Setting the course:

A lane 12 metres long and 1.2 metres wide is marked. Make a circle 6 metres in diameter on one end of the lane. The starting and finishing line is at the end of the lane opposite to the circle.

b. Competition:

The rider rides down the lane turning inside the circle and returning down the lane.

Time starts and stops upon entering and leaving the lane.
Start area rules apply

c. Elimination:

Rider will be eliminated if horse steps on or over a line with one or more feet.

d. Knock down of a start/finish peg
